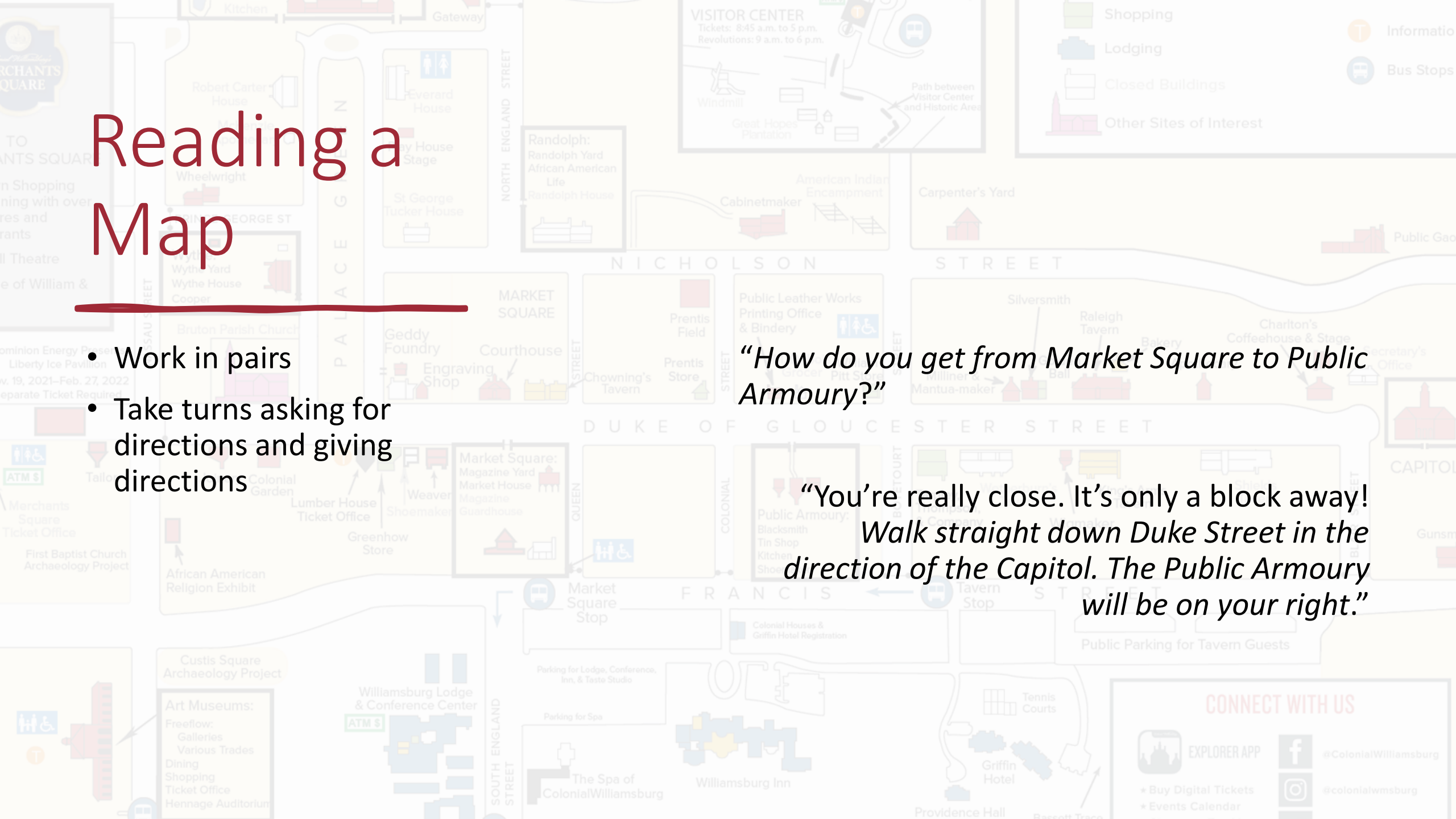

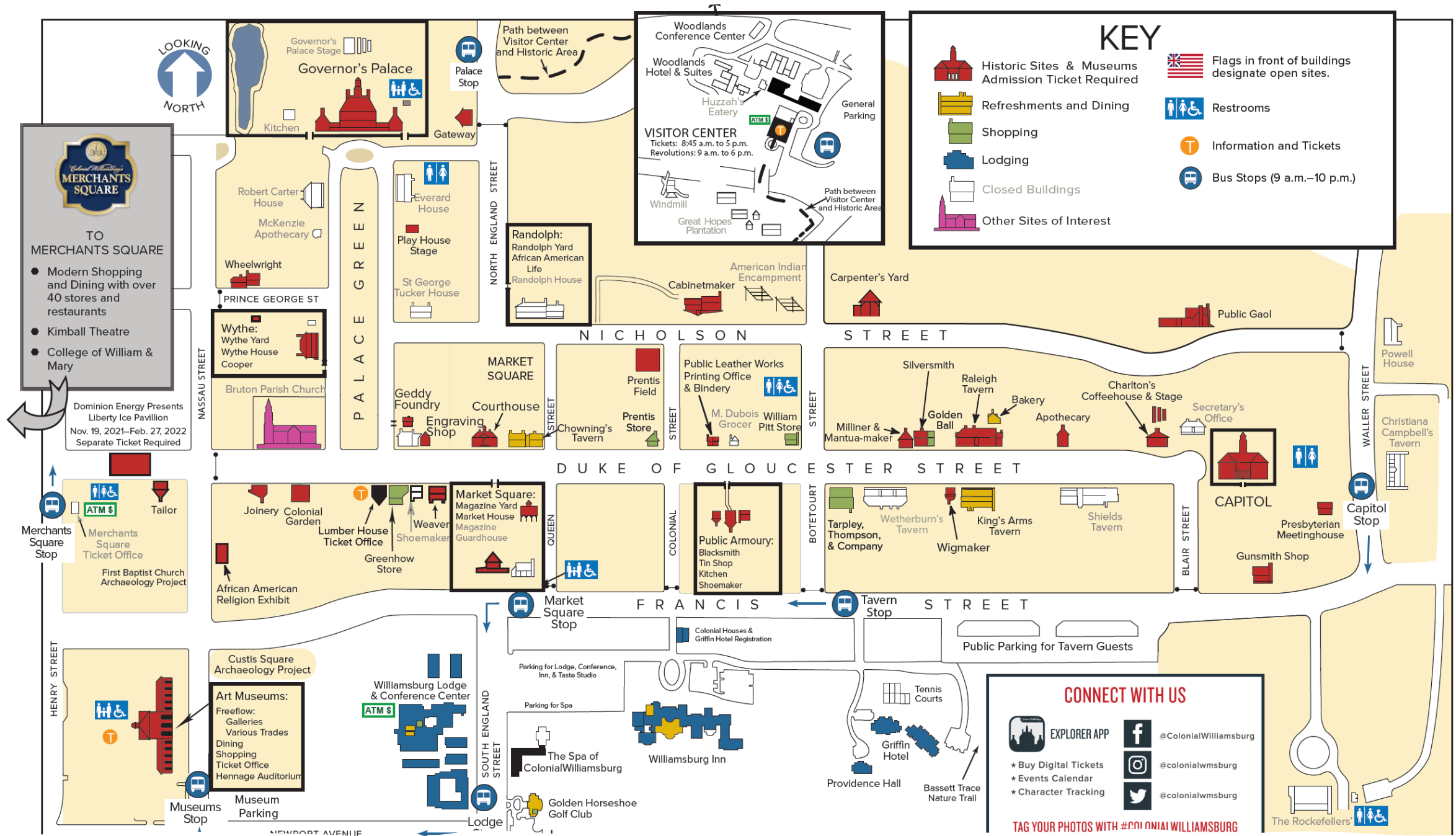
Reading a Map
