- 6. In which hemispheres is Marie Byrd Land?
- 7. What important longitude line passes through the Ross Sea?
- 8. If you traveled north along the longitude line that passes through the Vinson Massif which side of South America would you pass?
- 9. Which oceans border the Southern Ocean?
- 10. If you head north across the Ross Sea through which Pacific Islands countries would you pass?
- 11. If you followed the Prime Meridian from Greenwich England, United Kingdom south, in which part of Antarctica would you wind up?
- 12. Which latitude "line" marks the northernmost border of the Southern Ocean?
- 13. Which longitude line runs through the center of Wilkes land? What is the closest continent to this longitude?
- 14. If you followed the longitude line that runs through the Davis Sea which ocean would you cross? Which large country will you encounter at the intersection with 15° N?
