Deadline and Requirements:

- c) For ECPI there is no application deadline, but the requirements are a GPA of 2.5 or higher on a four-point scale. Your high school, average grade points, will also be considered before you are admitted into the nursing degree program.
- d) For South University, the application process is rolling, meaning they evaluate applications as they are received. A 2.75 or better on a four-point scale. Completion of 90 quarter hours (QH) of science and general education courses as required for admission to BSN degree program with a grade of C or better.
