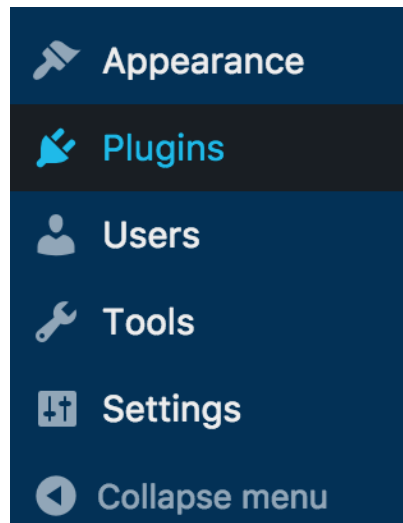


Embedding PDF Files

Easily embedding PDF files requires the activation of the PDF Embedder plugin. Once activated, this plugin allows for the embedding of PDF files when selected from the Media Library of a site.

Activating PDF Embedder



From the Dashboard, go to Plugins. In the right-hand search box, type in “PDF Embedder.”

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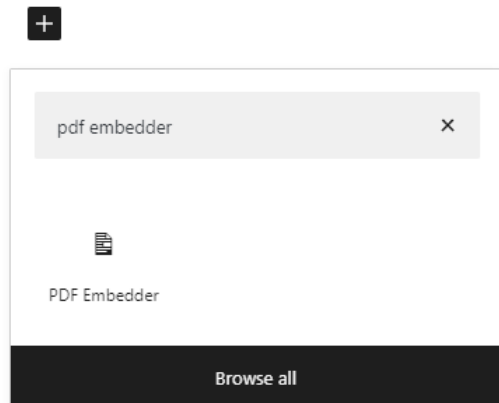

Click on “Activate” under the plugin name to activate and enable the plugin on the site.

Using PDF Embedder

Start writing or type / to choose a block



When editing a post or page, click on the plus sign button to “Add Block” button to search for and select “PDF Embedder”.

Click to open the Media Library, or upload the PDF file and then click the blue “Select” button in the lower, right-hand corner.

When inserted, WordPress will add the shortcode for embedding the PDF.

Clicking on the “Preview” (to see latest changes), “Publish” (if new post or page), or “Update” (if existing post or page) buttons will show the new, now embedded PDF file. At the bottom of the document, the menu will have two arrows where you can flip to the next document.
