 - Identify the salary range: \$60.00 per hour (Part time)
 - How much experience would be required to apply for that job? A BLS and RN
 certification is required and must be able to prepare and infuse hydration,
 IV pre-meds, and biological products. A minimum of 2 years as RN is required.
 - What degrees, certifications or training is required? A BLS certification and you must be a RN.
 - What skills are and tasks are involved in performing the job you have found?
 Some of the skills required are: knowledge in patient healthcare, IV start skills, and infused biologics. The tasks include: maintaining accurate patient records, managing schedules, IV placement and removal, handling blood draws, and patient assessments.

- How much experience would be required to apply for that job? A minimum of 3
 years of nursing experience is required and have graduated from a VA accredited
 school.
- What degrees, certifications or training is required? A Bachelor of Nursing Degree, training in pediatrics, emergency care, and Active Basic Life Support BLS CPR/AED for Healthcare Providers certification with hands-on training.
- What skills are and tasks are involved in performing the job you have found? The
 following skills are involved: sensory skills, organizational ability, ability to
 operate clinical equipment, commuter skills, oral skills, and coordination with
 school staff. The following tasks are performed at the job: assisting with health
 screenings, administering daily medication to students, implementing first aid,
 and maintaining standard safe procedures by student physicians.

- How much experience would be required to apply for that job? You need to have experience as an RN while also holding experience in a rehabilitation environment.
- What degrees, certifications or training is required? A license in VA as a RN is needed and basic computer training is required.

following skills are needed: interpersonal skills, patience, oral communication
skills, and strong clinical skills. The following tasks are involved: processing
patient medical records, reviewing medical history, planning health care patient
needs, and providing understanding in rehabilitation.
