

For outstanding performance of duty while serving as Correspondence/Directives Yeoman, Receipts Clerk, and Special Security Office Representative at Commander, Task Force 1060 and Cryptologic Warfare Group SIX from December 2015 to November 2017. During this period, Seaman Maupin flawlessly managed and processed 1,000 military pay documents and correspondence including more than 80 directives, 300 Dependency/Record of Emergency Data Applications, 120 monetary pay letters, 420 frocking letters, 180 Basic Allowance for Housing, Basic Allowance for Subsistence requests, 160 permissive temporary duty assignment orders, 150 advanced technical field advancement packages, 110 reservist orders, 86 statements of service, and 80 designation letters. While attached to the Special Security Office, she submitted 50 visitor requests, 26 in-briefs and de-briefs, and scheduled 39 counterintelligence polygraphs, ensuring over 2,000 Sailors gained access to their primary department in a timely manner to execute and accomplish mission requirements. As the Administration Department Assistant Command Fitness leader, she trained and prepared 52 Sailors on the fundamentals of fitness and physical readiness which led to a 98 percent pass rate during cycle 2 of the 2017 Physical Fitness Assessment. She facilitated nine physical fitness sessions that significantly enhanced the command's culture of physical fitness. Seaman Maupin's outstanding professional ability, personal initiative and loyal dedication to duty reflected credit upon her, U.S. Fleet Cyber Command, and the United States Navy.
