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After watching Mark Hofmann's TED talk on the dark side of AI, it's something that isn't surprising to me but opened my eyes a lot more. Throughout this course we learned about all these current threats about AI and how severe they're becoming. As Mark discussed human error is a huge issue in cybersecurity. Some questions I have is: What are we doing to prevent AI from misleading people? Why are we allowing so much power to AI systems? What can we do to ensure AI follow ethical values? I believe society needs to become aware of how powerful AI is becoming. Also understanding that it's predominately being used for ransomware attacks and deceiving people. Like Mark stated making sure our family and friends are aware of these threats.
