

Find Your Dream Job (100 Points)

Let's find your dream job! You will do research to find your dream job in the health field and what type of education and skills you will need to get this job. The purpose of this activity is to help you gain a better understanding of how your intended major, future education goals, and skills need to be applied to the career you want. **You will be expected to discuss this in class and it will be included on your ePortfolio.**

Research - 50 points

1. List your dream job or jobs. In a perfect world, one day you will be an Athletic Trainer. Briefly describe what you'll do in this role. What knowledge, skills, or abilities do you think you will need for this job?
 - In this role of being an athletic trainer for a professional sports team I will be working with athletes who have got injured or are recovering from injury. For this job an important skill to have is communication and leadership. You need to know what to do first when you see an athlete get injured and how you're gonna help them recover.
 - I would also be interested in working in a behind the scenes type of sports job too working with computers and looking into what goes on with programming games.

1. Job Posting Number 1: Certified Athletic Training

- a. Identify the salary range - \$57,930 a year in Virginia
- b. How much experience would be required to apply for that job, what degrees, certifications or training is required? - Experience needed is at least one year of clinic , a license/certification of athletic trainer
- c. What skills are and tasks are involved in performing the job you have found? - the skills with having experience working with collegiate athletes or professional

2. Job Posting Number 2: Analyst for Health Care

- a. Identify the salary range - \$95,000-\$115,000 per year
- b. How much experience would be required to apply for that job, what degrees, certifications or training is required? - bachelors in computer systems analysis , data processing , healthcare informatics , management information systems , 5+ years of working with health care quantitative analysis
- c. What skills are and tasks are involved in performing the job you have found? - working with computers , medical management , working with federal regulations

3. Job Posting Number 3: Collegiate Athletic Trainer

- A. Identify the salary range - \$54,463
- B. How much experience would be required to apply for that job, what degrees, certifications or training is required? - certification , clinical experience , internships , bachelor's degree
- C. What skills are and tasks are involved in performing the job you have found? - working with other athletes or trainers , communication , time management , and resilience

Part 2: Apply to your Dream Job - 50 points

1. Think about the job postings you submitted for Part 1, and the knowledge, skills, and abilities you'll need. Did these jobs match what you had in mind for your dream job? Did you find your dream job? Describe the similarities and differences.
 - For my dream job I listed big jobs that I want to go into being Professional Trainer for a sports team or either being behind the scenes of everything. After taking the quiz a Analyst for healthcare came to mind connecting with a dream job I had in mind. For this job you need strong communication , able to pay attention to detail , problem solving, critical thinking, and the ability to collaborate with healthcare professionals and present data for good decision making. Some differences it could have from being a regular trainer is the type of education you need which varies in by which field you go into and certification with data analysis. It can also relate to being a trainer with both working in sports and knowing the sport dynamics to be effective and having quick thinking and adaptability.
