Rational Choice Economic Theory:

Glass Washer Parts chose to minimize costs for their own self-interest through using a third-party company to host their website, and that provider company may have in some way saved money through having subpar cybersecurity systems which could have led to the attack being able to take place.

Laissez-fare Economic Theory:

The government didn't initially interfere to help protect customer information, however, they did become involved after the breach was discovered in order to help find the perpetrator(s).

Neutralization Theory:

The attackers hacked into the third-party platform provider system rather than directly into Glass Washer Parts where they were getting the data from, which could have caused them to feel removed from their victims and they could have rationalized to themselves either that their weren't any victims or that they may have deserved to become the victims of their attack.

Cognitive Theory:

Similarly to the neutralization theory, the criminals may have justified their actions or misunderstood who the real victims of their attack would be.
