Question-3 [5 points]: What is the significance of flowchart in Programming?

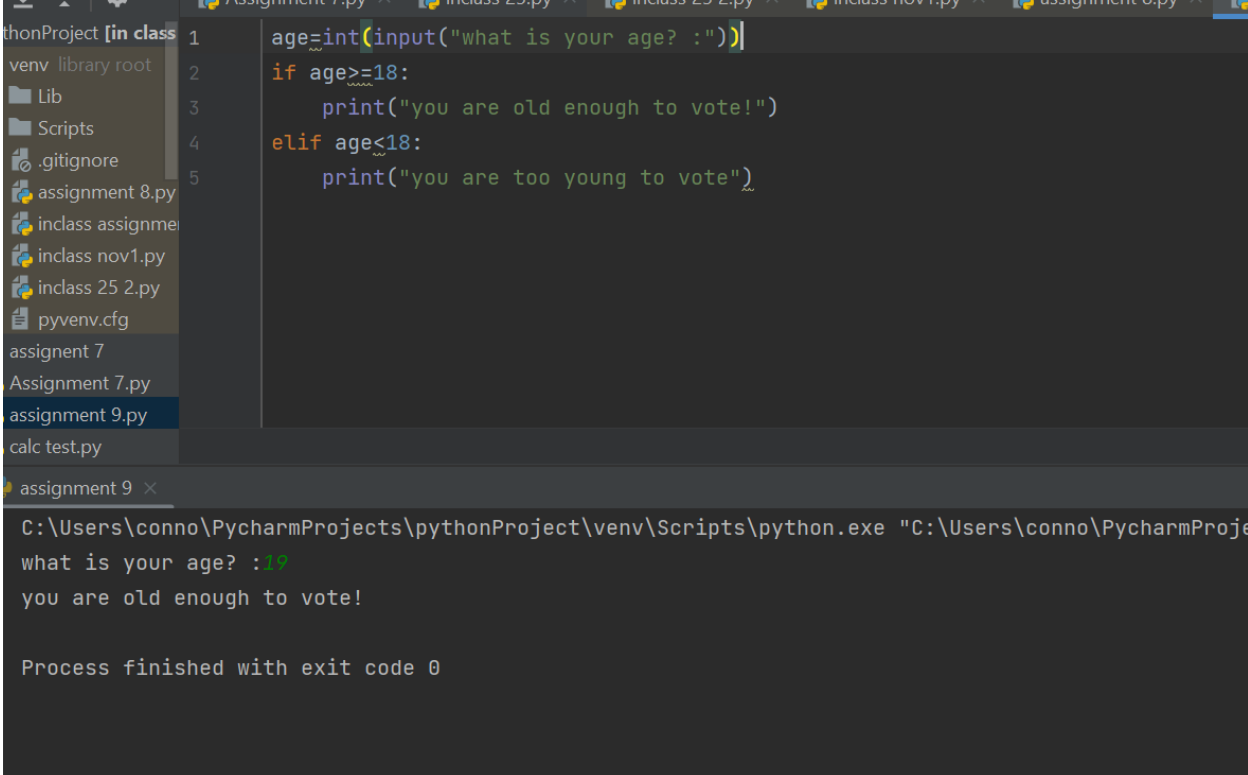
3. The flow chart is important because it gives a way for people to understand more clearly what the code is looking for and doing.
