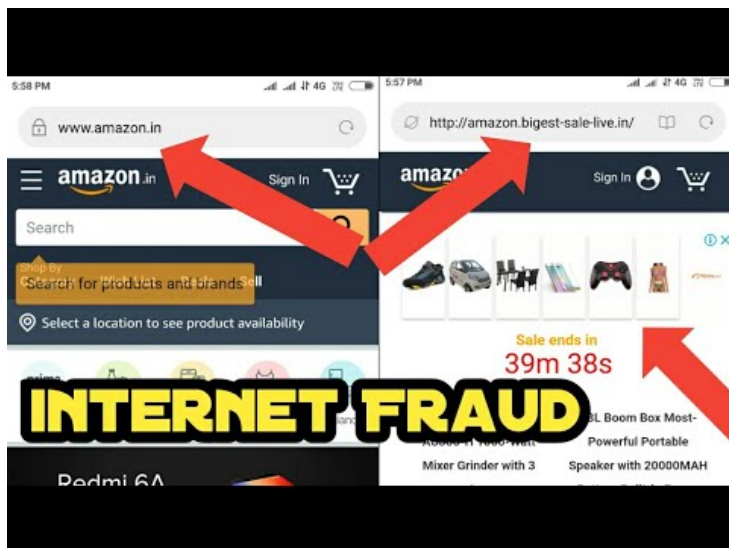
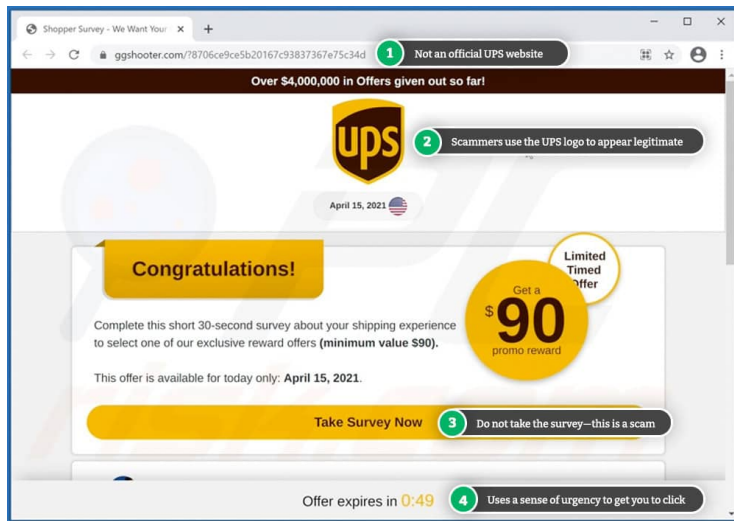


These two websites are almost exactly identical, the main difference that can tell the fake website from the real is the pixelated logo at the top of the website. Low quality images on these websites show a lack of professionalism and can tip off a victim to possible scamming websites.



This fake Amazon websites also look very similar; the main way one can be tipped off is by the domain addresses. The way real Amazon has the http in front of the address shows that the real Amazon website is more secure than the fake site, tipping off that the fake website could be leaking information to an outside source.



Finally the fake UPS website uses UPS real logo like the other sites and uses psychological tactics such as offering rewards for completing surveys that could be used to scam those who complete it and often don't result in the user receiving the reward they are promised in the offer.
