Another obstacle is the pronunciation. Breaking down the syllabus has been helpful but can make me feel insecure once I hear myself speak. It is something that may have held me back from being comfortable to complete the conversations. The knowledge of being judge based on my speech is a big fear. Another fear is the lack of preparation. I was able to submit a talk abroad and I felt more confident in my work.

Lingolearning helped with the gaining the most cultural perspective. It allowed me to watch videos to learn more about the culture. It challenged me to prepare myself more to study more to make sure I was not repeating the assignment more than twice. It revealed that studying more than one day a week was not enough. It is a consistent task.
