Rationale for Independent Study Equivalency

The Capstone Course is designed to allow students to synthesize their academic knowledge and skills into a culminating project, addressing advanced-level communication problems and demonstrating career readiness. A proposed independent study aligns with the course's structure, learning objectives, and expectations while allowing flexibility to focus on a unique project tailored to professional goals and interests.

This independent study will adhere to and demonstrate the <u>NACE Career-Ready Competencies</u>, ensuring the same rigor and depth as the Capstone Course. It will allow a student to independently design, research, and execute a project that fulfills all course requirements and deliverables, under the guidance of an approved faculty supervisor.

Proposed Project

Title: Strategic Communication Research and Collateral for Curriculum Redesign Project Description: As a strategic communication student, Dominick was seeking a project which aligns with his career goals and academic interests, while being able to complete the work remotely, and while working a full-time job. The program where he is matriculating, Strategic Communication, is undergoing a significant overhaul this year, with the major merging with Journalism. This significant change in our programming will require significant marketing and communication support. Under Program Director Brendan O'Hallarn (his adviser for the Independent Study) Dominick will conduct market research about equivalent degree programs in Virginia, and design promotional materials to be distributed to current and future students, as well as on the Department media channels (website, social media). In addition inquiry to current SC majors (a peer roundtable or two, held virtually as the student might be working remotely), and research on employer opinions/needs for new graduates of a Strat Comm program. (Perhaps that research is already available in another manner for this curriculum overhaul. The presentation should be held in a hybrid or virtual manner.

 Competency 1. Critical Thinking: Dominick will assess degree offerings at peer Virginia institutions, suggesting ways the program could be differentiated to aid in marketing efforts

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- Competency 2: Teamwork: Dominick will work with Brendan on determining promotional needs for the program, creating a workflow for producing these materials as well as having peer round tables and researching employers.
- Competency 3: Technology: Dominick will produce strategic communication tactics in different media forms (graphics, social, etc.) to aid in promoting the new, combined major

Proposed Deliverables:

- 1. Independent Project: The project consists of two distinct sections: 1. A research folio of peer programs in journalism and public relations particularly the nexus of these two, related disciplines; and 2. A series of strategic communication tactics which will be used by the Department of Communication & Theatre Arts to promote the new major. 3. inquiry to current SC majors (a peer roundtable or two, held virtually as the student might be working remotely) 4. research on employer opinions/needs for new graduates of a Strat Comm program.(NOTE: The research folio will take the place of the annotated bibliography ... source material will be collected and organized in a similar format)
- 2. **Project Reflection Blog Post**: Published on ePortfolio (WIX or Adobe), reflecting on how my coursework and this project have prepared me for my future career.
- Presentation: At the conclusion of the semester, Dominick will deliver a presentation on his work, The presentation should be held in a hybrid or virtual manner suggesting how he will help his career aspirations, as well as advance the goals of the new, combined major

At the completion of this independent study, I will demonstrate:

- **Identify** relevant theories, methodologies, and current scholarship within the field of my MAJOR to ground my project in disciplinary knowledge.
