Why are we doing this?

- The Program Prioritization Initiative of 2019 recommended the merger
- Dr. Jeremy Saks joined our department in Spring 2023 but nothing changed at first
- Started working on the merger in early 2024. Takes effect for freshman admits in Fall 2025
- One major two specializations
- 1. Strategic Communication
- 2. Journalism and Public Information
- Hopefully: A more focused education in the discipline students choose, but with exposure to the entire spectrum of Journalism-Strategic Communication education



How is it going to Impact current students?

- You will graduate with your current degree BA or BS in Strategic Communication, or BA in Journalism (from English)
- Some new classes; some classes changing names
- The entire new catalog is open to you, even if you won't see it on your degree works
- Take these new classes to meet Applied Theory requirements for your major
- Talk to your adviser! They'll know what is available to you
- One of the things that will be a significantly larger presence in the department is Journalism

Journalism education at ODU

- Journalism currently in the Department of English
- Students take two required journalism classes, plus at least two more from a list of journalism electives
- The new combined major will feature the same two required classes for the Journalism and Public Information specialization
- But the list of elective classes available to you all right now, is much larger
- Sport Journalism
- Media Relations
- Multimedia Journalism
- Arts Journalism
- Podcasting
- Some classes will apply to the Strategic Communication specialization

Benefits of our new combined major

- Strategic Communication students just saw their course offerings in the discipline go up by a lot
- Any journalism class can be counted as a Strategic Communication applied theory – even classes listed only in English (ENGL 486 Media Law & Ethics)

- The standard Senior Experience classes will still exist


