The 74th EDGD Midyear Conference in **Norfolk, Virginia**, promises to bring together a diverse audience to discuss the direction and focus of engineering design graphics across different disciplines of engineering education.

Submissions Overview: Authors are invited to submit a digest for presentation at the conference and inclusion in the conference proceedings. All submissions are peer-reviewed. Authors will have a choice to present in one of two formats: Paper Presentations or I2 (Innovations & Ideas) Presentations.

Presentations: Authors are invited to submit a 1200 - 1500 word digest for presentation at one of the conference oral sessions or the media showcase interactive session. Note that a digest is not merely an extended abstract, but rather a condensed summary of the work performed, including as much data and as many results and conclusions as possible. Digests are peer-reviewed. Authors of accepted digests must be present at the conference in order to have their digests included in the conference proceedings.

Grant Information: Two travel grants are available to support travel to the midyear conference: Rising Educator Award and Outstanding Educator Award.
