For each reading assigned do the following:

2 Quotes

Identify 2 key quotes that either

- Signal a significant event in the plotting
- Reveal something significant about how we should view a character
- Imply something more than or different from what is stated.

1.Write out the quote (1-2 sentences max usually).

- 2. **Cite** physical place in text with page, paragraph or line # in parenthesis For paragraphs: (par. 4).
 - For lines in poetry (7).
- 3. Write a brief paragraph of 3-4 sentences stating why you think this quote is important.

2 Questions: Pose 2 questions for class you would like to discuss. This can include:

- 1. Asking about quotes or specific places in the text you do not understand and want clarification.
- 2. Asking about where you think the interpretation may be complex, or have more than one way to look at it.
- 3. Asking about a specific literary element the author uses and its effect
- 4. Asking about how historical context might help you understand better- what kinds of information would shed light on a certain aspect of the story?
- 5. Asking about any aspect of the story you find interesting and wish to discuss in more depth.
