- 1. What led to the police investigation of Alberto Hill?
 - a. The hospital had gotten hacked and was dealing with widespread ransomware, which led to a police investigation.
- 2. How did Alberto gain access to the medical provider's database, and what did he do afterward?
 - a. He went through to the admin's account and typed in admin admin and a username and password to see if that would work. Once it did, he quickly reported it to CERT to notify the hospital so they could change it.
- 3. What was the hacker's demand in the 2017 medical records breach?
 - a. Demanded 15 bitcoins.
- 4. What evidence did the police find in Alberto's home, and how did it contribute to their suspicions?
 - a. They found all sorts of things, including: an anonymous mask, credit cards, computers, routers, phones, and bitcoin wallets.
 - b. It solidified their suspicions and made them think they caught their guy.
- 5. How did the authorities link the extortion email to Alberto, and what was his defense?
 - a. They pressured him to admit to sending that email or his girlfriend and mother's place would have been ransacked with his.

b. Due to this, he admitted to it, thinking he could kill 2 birds with one stone, have everybody save the hassle, and try to prove his innocence.
