The Dominion Energy Social Justice Scholars Program

is a postsecondary student professional development program designed to cultivate an ecosystem of social justice and build a coalition of support among college students, social justice-serving organizations and the communities they serve.

Program Components

- Social Justice Learning Series: April–July 2024
 - In-person and virtual professional development learning modules throughout spring and summer centered around:
 - Social justice strategies
 - Development of individual and/or group-based projects
 - Career pathways readiness in social justice
- Student Leadership Conference: May 29–June 1, 2024
- Internship with Social Justice Organization: June 3–July 26, 2024
- Capstone Convening: Late July 2024

Eligibility Criteria

- U.S. citizen or permanent resident
- Enrolled full-time at an accredited college/university in Virginia
- Minimum 2.75 GPA on 4.0 scale
- Classification: Junior at time of application
- Majors: Social Work, Pre-Law, Political Science, Education, Public Affairs/Public Administration, Criminal Justice, Urban Studies/Urban Affairs, Economics, Sociology, Psychology, History and related majors
- Has demonstrated leadership and community service during college tenure
