ACTIVITIES:

Provide a brief description of activities in lesson and the approximate time for each activity

Approximately 10mins spent on attendance. After attendance was taken students who brought clothes changed out while the other students sat on the bleachers. This took another 5-10mins. Student's then walked around the gym to music for warm up. During this time, cones we setup in each of the four corners of the gym so the kids could play "four corners". This is activity required students to pick a corner and begin to run and walk around the gym to music until it stopped. At this time the students must pick a corner to run to within 5 seconds. Students that were unable to make it to a corner were told to go to the middle of the gym and jump rope until the next time the music stopped. This lasted 10-15mins. Students who dressed out were told to change. This was the end of class.

STRATEGIES:

Mostly directed command approach.
