ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Master Sergeant Joe A. Munoz distinguished himself by outstanding achievement while assigned to 31st Aircraft Maintenance Squadron, 31st Maintenance Group, 31st Fighter Wing, Aviano Air Base, Italy. During this period, Sergeant Munoz's maintenance expertise was vital in his position as the 31st Maintenance Group's exercise project officer. In this capacity, he directly oversaw and coordinated the deployment of fourteen F-16s, movement of 138 cargo increments, 168 training munitions, and 10,349 rounds of twenty millimeter ammunition, on time and without incident to Andravida Air Base, Greece. Furthermore, Sergeant Munoz's astute knowledge of COVID-19 protocols and procedures enabled effective and timely coordination with host nation medical services and the 31st Medical Group to ensure the testing of 292 personnel, with one hundred percent arrivals before exercise start. Finally, his high-impact efforts directly resulted in the 31st Fighter Wing's successful participation in Exercise INIOCHOS 2021, reinforcing the combatant command's interoperability, partnerships with nine foreign and allied nations, and culminated in his recognition as an exercise superior performer. The distinctive accomplishments of Sergeant Munoz reflect credit upon himself and the United States Air Force.
