

With a partner online, play a true / false game about the family in the photo. Be sure to use words and phrases from recent lessons. Follow the instructions.

1. Before you connect online with your partner, look at the photograph and come up with 3 or 4 statements about it. Some statements should be true; and others, false. For example, you could say how many people are in the family, how they are related, their names, what pets they have, etc.

2. Then, connect with your partner online and record a conversation in Spanish. Do the following:

- Greet each other by name.
- Taking turns, one person says a statement about the photo and the other person indicates whether the information is true (**cierto**) or false (**falso**).
- If the answer is **falso**, that person must provide the correct information.
- Continue until each of you has made three true / false statements.
- To close the conversation, say thank you and good-bye.
