Hyper Text Transfer Protocol Secure is an internet protocol used to retrieve media from servers. The absence of this protocol in the Uniform Resource Locator in a website can be a sign that the website may be fake or unsafe. Limited contact information can be a sign that a website might be fake. Businesses often have phone numbers and emails that a customer can find and use to contact the business. Social media is often used to promote and market product and services that a business may be selling. Fake website may often be made without the intention of providing contact information because the goal of fake website is often to steal user's information.
