Thesis Statement/Central Idea: Today to show how to place an educated sports bet I will be using the betting odds for the upcoming Superbowl between the 49ers and Chiefs. Addressing how odds work first, then followed by how to research and place a Money line bet with the best potential payout and highest chance of completion.

Body: Odds

(Before we can go about learning how to place bets, you first have to understand odds)

- I. Underdog and Favorites and the use of plus minus
 - a. In sports betting there is always and underdog and a favorite of who will win.
 - i. The underdog will always be listed with a + symbol
 - ii. And the favorite is always listed with a symbol
- 1. The reasoning behind these symbols is to show how much the favorite is favored to win and vise versa
 - 1. The Superbowl odds are currently set at -130 49ers and +110 Chiefs
 - 1. Meaning the 49ers are the favorite
 - 1. Meaning they have a higher chance of winning according to the odds
- B. When using these numbers, they also show you the potential winnings as well
 - 1. Using the odds -110/+110 as an example
 - 1. If you place a 100 dollar bet on the +110 and it wins
 - 1. The total payout would be 210 dollars
 - 2. The net winnings being 110 dollars
 - 2. And if you place a 100 dollar bet on the contrary and it wins
 - 1. The total payout would be 190 dollars
 - 2. The net earnings being 90 dollars due to the odds favoring a win in this direction

(Now that we have a solid grasp on how odds work, I would like to talk about how to go about placing a Money line Bet reasonably and with an educated though process)

- II. Using the Superbowl once again
 - a. We will be discussing the best potential upside of the contest
 - i. Using a fictional 100 dollars to place a money line bet
 - ii. While Using Researching strategies to maximize winning efforts

A. Research is the most important part. Here are some of the main things to lookout for

- 1. Record of the teams involved
 - a. Shows how well the team has done previously before the playoffs in our situation.
- 2. Strength of schedule
 - a. This is a very important factor
 - i. If the team involved has a easier strength of schedule than another, it might indicate that they are not used to playing at the same level of competition
 - 1. Potentially giving the other team an edge in the gameplay
- 3. Roster/Inactive
 - a. Checking to see if players that are deeply influential in the game are playing or not is a very important key to success.
- 4. Temperature and environment of game
 - a. This is more important than people would like to give credit
 - i. If a team is used to playing in 75 degree weather, they may struggle in -3 degree weather with snow and windchill
- 5. Last but certainly the not least odds
 - a. How the odds first came out
 - b. How they changed overtime
 - c. How all of the other factors changed the odds
 - d. Odds are arguably the most important factor when looking at the entire scenario.

B. Using these 5 keys forms a sort of algorithm that allows you to make an educated bet using logic, research and mathematics to guide you to a decision when making a sports bet.
