He sold his first invention, the sewing machine belt for \$50. After working at the sewing machine shop, he was able to make many improvements to the machine that he decided to open his own shop. Also, he invented a breathing mask that we call a gas mask and it has saved many lives of firefighters and soldiers. He saved workers out of a tunnel when a gas pipe burst by using his gas mask. Later in years he was recognized for this with the International Association of Fire Engineers. Another big invention was the stop light because it has helped to keep everyone safe when driving and people crossing streets all over the world. Also, he donated to the Association of Colored Men and he founded the National Safety Device Company which was one of his greatest finds. One of his coolest invention to me was the straightening product for African Americans.
