

Find Your Dream Job (100 Points)

Let's find your dream job! You will do research to find your dream job in the health field and what type of education and skills you will need to get this job. The purpose of this activity is to help you gain a better understanding of how your intended major, future education goals, and skills need to be applied to the career you want. **You will be expected to discuss this in class and it will be included on your ePortfolio.**

Research - 50 points

1. List your dream job or jobs. In a perfect world, one day you will be _____. Briefly describe what you'll do in this role. What knowledge, skills, or abilities do you think you will need for this job?
 - In a perfect world, one day I will be a CRNA or just a RN. A CRNA is an advanced practice nurse who specializes in anesthesia care. They are responsible for administering anesthesia to patients undergoing surgery or other medical procedures, monitoring patients vital signs during the procedure, and managing their recovery from the anesthesia. A CRNA must know clinical and anesthesia knowledge, and skills such as critical thinking, communication, and technical. They both must also pay attention to detail, be compassionate, and have good teamwork skills. A RN is a nurse that assesses patients' health, develops nursing care plans, administers medications, and collaborates with other providers to provide care.

- a. Identify the salary range **Salary ranges from 78,000 to 90,000**
- b. How much experience would be required to apply for that job, what degrees, certifications or training is required? **It is required to have a minimum of 3 years in the OR as a circulating nurse at an acute care. It is also required to have a RN license**
- c. What skills are and tasks are involved in performing the job you have found? **It is expected that we work 24-40 hours per week and have a flexible schedule. It is also required to have some type of anesthesia knowledge.**

- b. How much experience would be required to apply for that job, what degrees, certifications or training is required? **You must have your RN license, and ACLS**
- c. What skills are and tasks are involved in performing the job you have found? **You must have previous experience in Anesthesia, Nursing, Ortho, trauma nursing**

 - **If I could choose one of the jobs I want most I would choose job posting #2. I do have critical thinking skills, communication, and teamwork skills that would make me a good candidate for this job.
