For outstanding meritorious service while serving a member of Dive Department at Naval Research Laboratory Site Detachment (Sea Component), California while engaged activities Hueneme, in significance to the Government of the United States from December 2016 to August 2017. Petty Officer Creger consistently performed his demanding duties in a highly professional manner. As an Unlimited Diving Supervisor, his superior technical knowledge, attention to detail, and timely recommendations resulted in the safe and efficient execution of complex high-risk, open ocean deck and diving evolutions despite the high stress environment in which the command operated. His demonstration of maturity and calm under pressure ensured mission success during an at-sea training period and two readiness inspections resulting in the successful completion of two Chief of Naval Research missions vital to national security.
