



Task: Let's travel back in time to experience your birthday!

Directions: Construct a calendar using a blank template. The month of your birth will be your focal point. You will be required to turn in your calendar which will be graded as a quiz. You will also give a descriptive presentation of your calendar orally that will count a class participation grade. The same grading scale will be used for the calendar that you turn in as well as for your presentation.

Use <https://www.almanac.com/weather/history> to look up weather information in reference to the day you were born. You will write a sentence using the verb hacer in present tense to respond to the question ¿Qué tiempo hace hoy? Describe the weather as it was on the day you were born. Remember that we are flashing back to the day you were born. Conjugate the verb hacer/estar + the correct adjective to describe the weather for today.

ex. H/E_____ (hacer or estar conjugated) _____ (descriptive adjective) _____(write the word "today" in spanish).

The following additional information must be presented on your calendar in Spanish: Months, Days of the week, write the numerical day of your birthday spelled out in word form. The rest of the number days maybe written in number form. Weather sentence must be written at the bottom of the calendar month that corresponds with your birthday. Remember that the weather information must be written by using the verb hacer or estar to describe the weather in present tense. If you have extra time when you complete this activity, practice writing the numbers on the calendar in written form.
