- Identify the salary range: The weekly salary of a travel nurse is about \$2,000, on average, with a potential sign on bonus offered by most companies. This salary can vary heavily based on location, company, length of contract, and need.
- How much experience would be required to apply for that job? At least two years of acute care experience is required by most companies.

- What degrees, certifications or training is required? A bachelor's degree of science in nursing (BSN), a RN license, a BLS certification, and an ACLS certification is required by most companies.
- What skills are and tasks are involved in performing the job you have found? Travel nurses work on contracts with a hospital or clinical care setting through a private company. Their duties can vary, but most jobs include patient care, supporting fellow staff members, and carrying out care plans made by physicians.

- Identify the salary range: \$76,000-\$117,000 is the annual pay of a pediatric nurse practitioner.
- How much experience would be required to apply for that job?
 Work experience in the clinical care setting is required by most companies.
- What degrees, certifications or training is required?
 A bachelor's degree of science in nursing (BSN), a RN license, a master's degree in nursing (MSN), and a BLS certification is required by most companies for this job.
- What skills are and tasks are involved in performing the job you have found? Pediatric nurse practitioners are involved in the diagnostics, treatment, and monitoring of chronic and acute diseases in minors, prescribing medication, performing medical tests, and collaborating with other medical professionals.

- Identify the salary range: The average annual salary of a CRNA is \$212,000. Those starting out usually make around \$135,000, while senior CRNAs make around \$250,000.
- How much experience would be required to apply for that job?
 Two years of acute care work experience is required to begin working as a CRNA.
- What degrees, certifications or training is required?
 One must earn a bachelor's degree of science in nursing (BSN), a RN license, a master's degree of science in nursing (MSN) from a nurse anesthesia program, pass the Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetist exam, and maintain the CRNA license with the completion of continued education hours.
- What skills are and tasks are involved in performing the job you have found? CRNAs have a large job description as they are responsible for assessing and communicating with patients, interacting with other professionals in the medical field, administering anesthesia and other medications, and monitoring those recovering from a procedure that required anesthesia.

Reflection: From the 3 job postings you found, choose one job you want the most. Why does this job appeal to you the most? What skills do you already possess that would help you to get this job? Identify skills you are still building or need more experience performing. Discuss options to sharpen or learn the skills you will need to gain.

Out of these three jobs, I feel as though my dream job would be a CRNA. I have been looking further into this job for quite some time because I find the calculations and patient interactions

to be the most interesting and rewarding aspect of the nursing field. The schooling is intense, but the reward afterward will be worth it, I feel. I possess several skills already that will aid me in this profession, such as organization, adaptability, and determination. I will need to build my multitasking abilities and work experience in a medical setting before embarking on such an endeavor.
