What to do to make it work

- Make orderfillers place the labels when their trip ends
- Check that the labels are in the correct position
- Make sure associates are doing their job to keep the process flowing
- Monitor three times a day
- Temporary Audit
- Create a flyer like the One Best Way Walmart with the specifications of the DC 7016

Shrink Wrap Machine Staging Area

- Each Shrink Wrap Machine will have a staging area to support first in, first out for orderfilled pallets.
- The staging area lanes must have a flow pattern for orderfilling, and wrap/haul associates based on the layout of the dock.
 - Orderfillers will have to come straight to "Lane 1" first and then move to the next lane.
 - After the first trip is staged in the first lane, the other trips must be placed consecutively next to the first trip.
 - Wrap/Haul associates must empty "Lane 1" first and then move to the next lane.
 - This is to make sure that pallets do not stay idle on the dock for an extended period of time.



The 21/90 rule

Commit to a new work method for 21 straight days. After three weeks, the pursuit of that goal should have become a habit. Once they have established that habit, they continue to do it for another ninety days. If you can keep up something for three weeks and then ninety days, then it should become a permanent lifestyle change.
