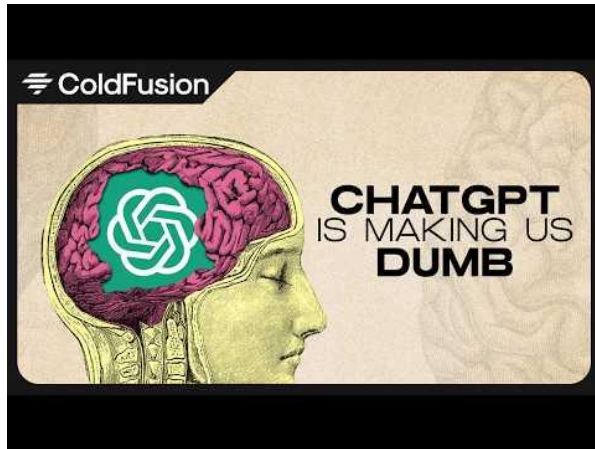


## Is AI making Us Dumber?
