

CBP: CHILDHOOD LANGUAGE

GOALS

- To improve auditory memory and comprehension, the client will accurately paraphrase the main idea and 3 details of a story with 90% accuracy given verbal prompting over 4 out of 5 sessions for 2 months.
- To improve articulation, the client will accurately produce /r/ in the final position of words at the word and phrase-level with 80% accuracy given visual cues over 4 out of 5 sessions for 2 months.

ABC

- A= visual aids including notecards, picture boards, and writing in real-time
- B= self-correcting during spontaneous speech
- C= natural positive reinforcement for demonstration of accurate production.

FACILITATION TECHNIQUES

To create nonexistent communication....

- When targeting paraphrasing the clinician will utilize the cloze technique by omitting words from a passage so the client is forced to use background knowledge of vocab, interest, and higher order thinking skills to fill in the blank and complete the thought

BEHAVIOR MODIFICATIONS

Continuous Positive Reinforcement

- When the client elicits /r/ in the final position accurately, the clinician will use a clicker and "click" to reinforce the desired response
