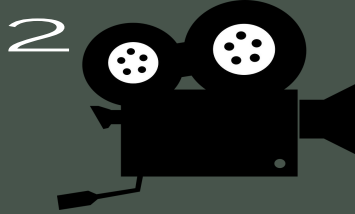

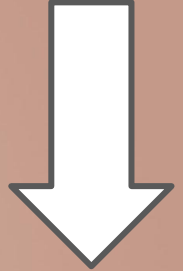

# What Is a Digital Footprint?

“A digital footprint is the trail of data you create when you go online.

Included in it are emails you send, websites you visit, and other information you may submit online. Whenever you share content, post something online, or allow cookies to collect your information, you are adding to your digital footprint. All online activity leaves a digital trail.

This can include your login details, IP address, and other personal information” (GoGuardian Team, 2020).
