

Can you spot three fake websites and compare the three fake websites to three real websites, plus showcase what makes the fake websites fake?

Note: Don't generate/access or click on any unwanted/fake websites on your web browsers. Showcase with examples, what makes the fake websites fake.

Fake websites are often tricky to find but usually, clear warning signs distinguish them from real ones. For example, fake websites usually have a suspicious domain name. Here is an example of a fake website that uses a suspicious website, [go0gle-search.xyz](#). Though it is easy to spot this as a fake website, some people overlook this and don't check the website. The real website is obviously [google.com](#). Another example is if the website has poor design/ functionality. [Paypall.com](#) is hard to spot but the website works poorly. It is probably fake. The real website is obviously [paypal.com](#). The website could also be very suspicious because of the content it offers. Like the website could give something that is too-good-to-be-true. For example, [cheapnikeoutlet.com](#) offers \$20 for Nike Shoes. This is obviously fake and you shouldn't fall for it. The real website is [nike.com](#)
