Throughout all of my time working at CCPS I have worked for over 150 hours and a lot of new things have happened. We have finished updating the Chromebooks for all of the middle schoolers and have done a large amount of repairs on the devices we had been working with. I was tasked to return many of the repair laptops to their respective classrooms which took a lot of heavy lifting. Once that was completed our next group of students to work on was kindergarten.

We were asked to update and label a large sum of Chromebooks to take to the kindergarteners labeled by the teacher and students' names. The students were numbered and then placed into a bin for transport which I and the other interns were responsible for driving to the locations. An older model of laptop carts required that the cables that we rolled up had to be undone and the cable of each charger had to be run across the top of the cart one by one.
