After completing the Patchin and Hinduja's cyber bullying survey, criminologists might find the cyber bullying surveys useful in their research and studies regarding cybercrime and society's response to those crimes. A criminologist might consider all the different items in the cyber bullying survey to study how many people get bullied online and how often. They can find out what kind of platforms users get bullied on the most and why it doesn't occur at all or as much on other sites or applications. They can study how it makes the users and or victims feel when they get bullied along with the after affects, what they feel long term, and to what extent of bullying is occurring. Studying what people are posting and if it is correlated to why they are getting bullied or the type of information they are posting is making them vulnerable to scamming or attacks. With all these objectives in mind, a criminologists can see patterns by analyzing the behaviors of victims and the cyber bully or attacker.
